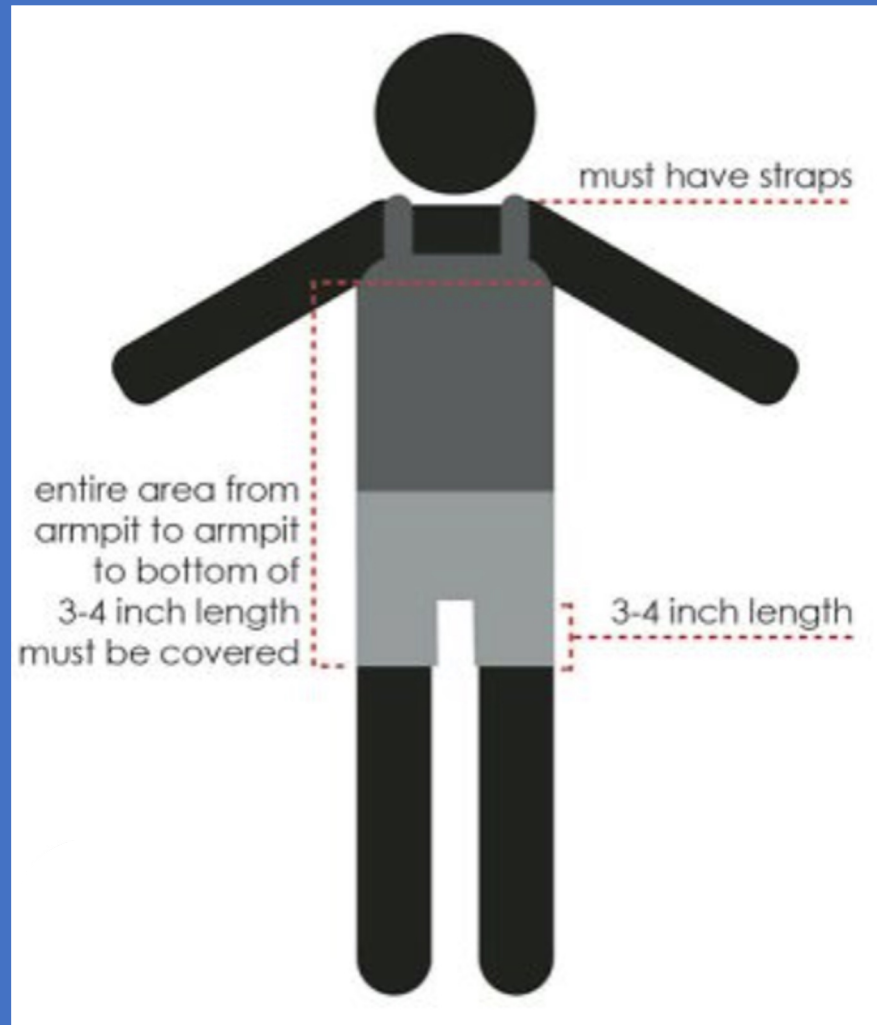
Snacks & Lunch
